CHALLENGES

Some people are self employed some work in informal businesses such as taxi industry their salaries/ profit maybe far higher than people who are working but still register themselves as indigent, and therefore create a burden on the little resources the municipality may have.

Registered indigent, when their status change for better they don't come and update or deregister.

The municipality does not have a social welfare division/ unit which will register and evaluate all applicants and services so that the free basic services is received by the intended people.

The scourge of HIV and aids increases the number of indigents on the municipal resources.

MUNICIPAL INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT (MIG)

As Steve Tshwete we have spent more than 90% of the MIG on infrastructure.

Comprehensive infrastructure grant assist municipalities to address developmental challenges, in our case we have built a beautiful park at extension 7.

To deal speedily and effectively with the challenges facing municipalities and our country today, a consolidated effort from both government and private sector is important. Shaduka has committed to build ECD centre and houses in our area therefore this workshop is

coming handy for government and private sector to combine resources for service delivery.
